**WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE PRESENTS WORKS
BY FOUR ARTISTS IN NOVEMBER**

Westchester Community College's Fine Arts Gallery presents *Color by Numbers: Linda Jean Fisher, Sue Havens, Cheolhwan Kim, Joe Stauber* from November 6 through November 27. An opening reception will be held on Sunday, November 6 from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. Both the reception and the exhibition are free and open to the public. Each of the four artists approach color through an application of mathematics or geometry.

Linda Jean Fisher graduated from Westchester Community College and went on to the School of Visual Arts in New York City. She lives in **Peekskill** and has shown her work throughout the region. She focuses on groups of numerals, with works which include numerous notations on the percentage of tints used to create various colors. **Sue Havens** holds an MFA from Bard Graduate Center and lives and works in New York City. Irregular geometric patterns play a large role in her paintings, which include polka dots, stripes, and grids.

Cheolhwan Kim served as an MP in the Korean army prior to graduating from SUNY Purchase and later earned an MFA from Cornell. He employs geometric "op-art" patterns, usually in saturated colors, which frequently serve as a backdrop for black and white figures. **Joe Stauber** holds an MFA from SUNY Purchase and teaches printmaking at Pratt. The most overt geometric aspect of his work is his use of military battlefield diagrams; he also paints the letters and numerals of snippets of computer code into his pieces.

The Fine Arts Gallery is located on the third floor of the Academic Arts Building, across from the Academic Arts Theatre. It is open Monday through Saturday, 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and Thursday evenings 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. For further information, phone 914-606-7867.
