## Registration Checklist:

**Payment for Tuition**- Full payment is due in person by Friday, August 4th by 11:30 pm and online at the mywccportal by 9:00 pm on Sunday, August 6, 2017. Students who do not make full payment or who are not fully covered by financial aid or other sources will have their courses deleted on August 6.

**Beginning August 7<sup>th</sup>** you must have one of the following payment arrangements in place prior to registering for Fall 2017:

1. Make payment in full or be fully covered from your company/third party
2. Enroll in the payment plan and make the scheduled payments
3. Financial Aid (awards/loans must be anticipated/pending on your account)

As of the first day of the semester (depending on campus or extension site), students who fail to complete the terms of their arrangements to cover their full account, **may be deleted from their classes and will be responsible for the charges incurred according to the refund schedule.** If you do not plan on attending Westchester Community College this Summer and/or Fall, you must drop your classes prior to the first day of the semester in which you are registered. **If you do not, all tuition and fees incurred are your responsibility.**

Thereafter, please check sunywcc.edu/bursar for the schedule. Employer or financial aid vouchers are only accepted at the Valhalla campus.

**Placement Testing**- Testing is required for first time full-time and part-time students who plan to take Math and/or English.

A submitted Admissions Application with a Photo ID and your Student ID Number are needed to test.

**Proof of Immunization**- According to NYS Public Health Law, if you were born in 1957 or later, and taking 6 or more credits, you must provide documentation of 2 Measles, 1 Mumps, and 1 Rubella. Meningitis information response must also be submitted.

**Tuition Rate**- Must be a New York State resident for at least one year and a Westchester resident for at least six months to pay the resident tuition rate \$179 per credit.

**Certificate of Residence**- Needed for the lowest tuition rate for those who are a New York State resident, but do not reside in Westchester County. A Certificate of residency must be submitted to the College annually.
