Online Registration

Online registration is open to returning students whose academic and student accounts are in good standing (without “holds”). To register online, visit www.sunywcc.edu/MyWCC and follow the *How To Register* instructions on the login screen. Note that your User ID and Password are required. For questions about holds, contact 914-606-5600.

In-person Registration

Full-service, in-person registration is available to returning students in good standing during regular business hours on the Valhalla campus (Administration Building, Registrar’s Office, Room 107) and at our Ossining, Mount Vernon, Peekskill, White Plains, and Yonkers extension locations. Visit the website at www.sunywcc.edu/registrar for registration office hours. Continuing students who are taking developmental (zero-credit) classes or students with a cumulative GPA of less than a 2.0 should visit the Student Center, Room 222 to meet with a counselor.

New Student Registration

Before new students can register for classes, they must submit an application and be accepted to the college. Once accepted, registration for classes may be completed online through the MyWCC student portal. Portal log in instructions and a required, personal Student ID Number will be mailed to students upon college acceptance. Apply online at www.sunywcc.edu/apply.
