- 2) Bring complete 2016 income tax and W2 forms for you, your spouse and your parents, if applicable, and make copies of these forms.
- 3) Collect proof of all non-taxable income received by you and your family members for 2016 (e.g. budget sheets, workman's compensation, child support, social security SSA1099, unemployment, etc.)
- 4) Bring copies of 2016 income tax forms and proof of non-taxable income received in 2016 to one of the following Financial Aid Workshops:
