What is a Portfolio Review?

- Representatives from art schools review student portfolios for admission or transfer
- Students receive feedback and advice about how to improve their portfolios
- Students can ask questions about programs of study, admissions/transfer requirements, scholarship opportunities, and financial aid

What should I bring?

- Bring examples of your very best original work (about 12-15 pieces)
- Representatives are especially keen on seeing work from direct observation, such as still lifes, landscapes, or drawings from a live model
- Slides or good photographs may be used for works that are too large to transport, but original work is preferred
- Work does not need to be matted or framed, but neatness in presentation does count
- Digital work may be presented on laptops (students should bring their own to be safe), but digital prints should be brought as back up
- Representatives want to see a broad cross-section of creative skills, so include as many media as possible in your portfolio
- Journals and sketchbooks are also good! They like to see how your creative mind works!

What if I don't have a portfolio yet?

- Come anyway!
- You can still ask questions and learn by watching others!
- This is a learning opportunity you won't want to miss!
