

## White Plains – Classes for Children and Teens

Classes for children are designed to meet their special needs: small groups for individualized instruction, experienced teachers, and a friendly creative environment. The program offers a broad range of classes for students from 6-15 years of age, classes meet once a week Monday through Thursday throughout the year. All classes are held in fully equipped studios. The Art Workshop maintains very modest fees, including all materials and supplies, so all can attend. For their safety and security, children may not leave the building or school unescorted by an adult.

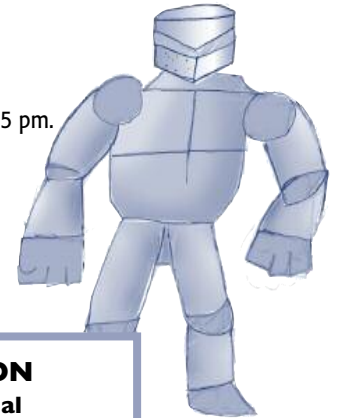

**CARTOONING:** This class will delve into the weird and wonderful world of cartooning. Students will be encouraged to create characters and develop storyboards based on the individual student's interests.

Students will explore how to make their characters come to life through emotive gesture drawing and the exploration of caricature.

**CERAMICS:** Children will learn to think visually and develop creativity through the use of clay. Fundamental lessons in technique and tool utilization will increase as students are exposed to the visual language of shape, line, form, and texture. Although a step-by-step process is provided, the course will be structured by the spontaneous energy, interest, and participation of the students themselves.

**DRAWING FOR ANIMATION:** This class will focus on preparing students to create their own animations through intensive drawing and studying how to articulate movement. Students will be exposed to contemporary and traditional animation techniques and will be encouraged to develop a drawing language that is both personal and sophisticated.

This class will be based on the development of traditional skills and will culminate in a short animation sequence by each student.

**JEWELRY:** The creative aspects of the art of metalworking will be emphasized in this introductory course. Students will design and construct necklaces, bracelets, pins, and other objects in a fully equipped jewelry studio.

**MIXED MEDIA:** A variety of experiences in different media in which the young child explores the visual arts through the use of different materials, making 2 and 3 dimensional projects.

**PAINTING AND DRAWING:** An introduction to the variety of materials, tools, and techniques of two-dimensional art. Class exercises will explore color, composition, still-life, landscape, and portraiture. Advanced students who have fundamental experience in painting and drawing will be taught to refine their skills through a series of exercises emphasizing realism and craftsmanship.

### Portfolio Preparation and Presentation in Computer Arts

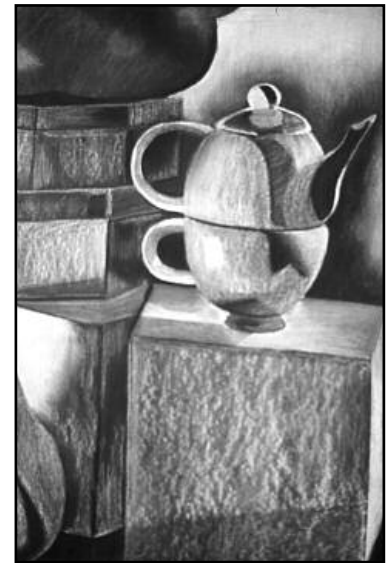
**September 19 – December 3**
