## Directions

### By Car

From the south:

1. Sprain Parkway North to the Taconic Parkway
2. Get off at the first exit, Route 117-Pleasantville
3. At the end of the exit ramp, make a left turn onto Route 117 West.
4. Take Route 117 West to Route 9 North
5. Follow Route 9 North for approximately 2.5 miles
6. Make a left into the Arcadian Shopping Center
7. Make the second left (after the McDonalds)
8. Follow signs to WCC Center; Ossining Extension Center is on right

From the north:

1. Taconic Parkway South to exit Route 100
2. At the end of the exit, make left turn onto Route 100 South
3. Follow Route 100 South to Route 9A South
4. Take Route 9A South to Route 117 (left hand exit)
5. At the end of the exit ramp, make right turn onto Route 117 West
6. Follow directions from step #4 above

### By Bus

Take Bee line bus #13 or #14. If taking #14, transfer at Spring & Main Street stop in Ossining for #13. The bus stop for Ossining Extension Center is at the Arcadian Shopping Center.

### By Train

Take MetroNorth Hudson line and get off at Scarborough stop. Make left onto Kemeys Avenue. Follow road for about 1/4 mile. Ossining Extension Center is on the right

### Infection Control for Phlebotomy Students

The required pre-prerequisite for students entering Phlebotomy. The course is designed for entry level health care professionals and includes key infection control concepts and New York State regulations regarding safe work practices.

### Phlebotomy

This course introduces the basic concepts and procedures used for obtaining blood from veins and capillaries. The use of appropriate equipment and types of blood tubes are explained.
