Registration Checklist

Payment for Tuition- No employer or financial aid vouchers are accepted at extension centers.

Placement Testing- Testing is required for first time full-time and part-time students who plan to take Math and/or English. An Application to Admissions must be submitted prior to testing. **(Photo ID Required)**

Proof of Immunization- According to NYS Public Health Law, if you were born in 1957 or later, and taking 5 or more credits, you must provide documentation of 2 Measles, 1 Mumps, and 1 Rubella. A meningitis information response must also be submitted.

Tuition Rate- Must be a New York State resident for at least one year and a Westchester County resident for at least six months to pay the resident tuition rate. See out of county information below.

Certificate of Residence- Needed for the lowest tuition rate for those who are a New York State resident, but do not reside in Westchester County. A Certificate of residency must be submitted to the College annually.
