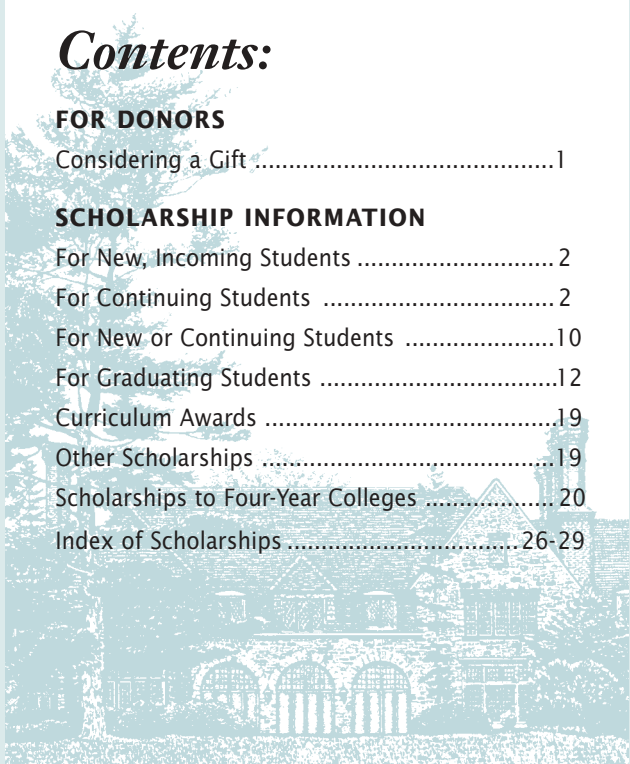

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

(Recent high school graduates or other students who have little or no post-high school education.)

NANCY JO ABELES SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are given to incoming students of merit who demonstrate potential and plan to attend Westchester Community College full-time. The award amount may vary from year to year, but is generally around \$1,500 per year.

ESTHER DUTTON KATES FELLOWSHIP

At the behest of Paul W. Kates, this two-year fellowship is awarded annually to a single (i.e. unmarried, divorced or widowed) mother in need of financial assistance who plans to attend Westchester Community College full-time for two years. The Fellowship provides support in any field of study, and the award amount ranges from \$2,500 to \$3,000 for each year.

OLIVIA J. MOSHIER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established by the family of Olivia J. Moshier, this award of \$500-\$1,000 assists a new student who intends to pursue either a business or fine arts major, who demonstrates high potential and has economic need.

WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE FACULTY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Funded by contributions from the Westchester Community College faculty, this award is given to a new student who has demonstrated outstanding academic achievement in his or her high school career. The scholarship will be renewable at full tuition for the recipient's second year if a 3.25 GPA is achieved.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS

(Those who have completed some academic work at Westchester Community College or other institution beyond high school, and who have at least one semester of study remaining at Westchester Community College.)

Some awards, related to specific curriculum areas or college service, are determined by other college departments or committees and may have a special application form and determination process. These awards are designated by an asterisk (*). Inquire at the particular department or the Foundation office.

*NANCY JO ABELES HONORS SCHOLARSHIPS

These competitive scholarships are awarded to students enrolled in the Westchester Community College Honors Program who have successfully completed two honors courses and plan to take a minimum of two honors courses during the year of the award. The award amount may vary from year to year, but is generally \$1,250 per semester.

NANCY JO ABELES 2ND YEAR MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are given to continuing students of merit who attend Westchester Community College on a full-time basis. The award amounts may vary from year to year, but is typically \$1,000 per semester.

ALPHA GROUP SCHOLARSHIP

In honor of Dr. Joseph N. Hankin's twenty-fifth year as president of Westchester Community College, the Alpha Group, an organization of chief executive officers, established an endowed scholarship for a student who has excelled in a business-related curriculum.

ASIAN STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This award, made possible by the Far Eastern Club of Westchester Community College, is available to an Asian student who is a permanent resident or U.S. citizen. The recipient must have completed at least 12 credits with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better. The student must enroll for a minimum of six credits during the term of the award.

LEO BENARDO LANGUAGE SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated academic excellence in two or more language courses at Westchester Community College.

KATHLEEN BUCCI MEMORIAL BOOK SCHOLARSHIP

This \$250 award is given to a second-year student in the Associate degree in Nursing program at Westchester Community College who has a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25. The student must use the funds to purchase books and supplies at the College bookstore.

ZOE CALDWELL NEW CENTURY SCHOLARSHIP

This \$2,500 scholarship is given to a second-year Westchester Community College student pursuing studies in Arts or Humanities.

CHALLENGER AWARD

The Challenger Award, established by an anonymous donor, assists resourceful, responsible, working single mothers to continue studying at Westchester Community College by helping them with general living expenses. A preference will be given to students in the nursing program. Award amount may vary from \$200 to \$1,500, as may the number of awards.

COWAN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships, established by Foundation board member Lois Cowan and her husband Marvin, are awarded to second-year students who exhibit merit and need.

ANGELO DELGROSSO ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

Established by alumni/ae of Westchester Community College in honor of the college's retired Dean of Students, this award recognizes a student who has demonstrated academic achievement while making contributions to the enrichment of the quality of the student experience through participation in a major extracurricular activity.

CAROL DOYLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award remembers the outstanding and dedicated career of a loving nurse, mentor and friend. It is presented to a second year female student enrolled in the ADN program who demonstrates enthusiasm, dedication and leadership in nursing.

CHARLES H. DYSON SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships of \$250 are awarded to part-time students with high academic rank.

IRENE ECONOMOU MEMORIAL FUTURE TEACHER'S SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships were established by Professor Stella Economou in memory of her twin sister. The awards are given to students who wish to pursue a career in teaching.

DAVID FALK ESL SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships, of varying amounts, are presented to students for whom English is a second language. Awards may also be made to English as a Second Language students in the non-credit programs.

WILLIAM FRIEDMAN MEMORIAL AWARD

An award of \$400 is given to a second year student who has a 3.5 GPA and has completed Engineering Physics I and II and Calculus I and II with A's in three out of the four courses.

THE FUJI PHOTO FILM U.S.A. SCHOLARSHIPS

Two awards of \$1,500 each are awarded to students enrolled in the Liberal Arts, Business, Marketing or Communications curricula, who have a GPA of 3.0 or better, and have demonstrated financial need.

GLICKENHAUS SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships, ranging from \$500 to \$1500 per year, are presented to minority students with significant financial need.

MARY LOU GRECO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award is presented to a student enrolled in either the LPN or ADN program at Westchester Community College. Preference is given to students interested in trauma nursing.

GREENWICH WOODS NURSING SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$5,000 scholarships are awarded to students in the Associate degree in Nursing program, and may be applied to tuition and fees, books, and nursing supplies. In addition to the scholarship, recipients are paid to work a minimum of 16 hours per week at the Greenwich Woods Health Care Center in Greenwich, CT, and are committed to working for a period of two years after graduation.

DR. JOSEPH N. HANKIN BOOK AWARDS

Established by friends, family and colleagues in honor of Dr. Hankin's twenty-fifth anniversary, up to fourteen awards will be given annually to help students purchase books.

MARK HANNA SCHOLARSHIP

Established by the Helmsley Charitable Trust in recognition of the superb care Westchester Community College Professor Mark Hanna provided Harry Helmsley during his final illness, the scholarship provides \$1,000 to one or more outstanding student(s) in the Respiratory Therapy curriculum.

K.M. KAUNG, T. C. KAUNG MEMORIAL, & YUE-SUNG KAUNG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are made available to students who have completed at least 12 credits with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better. The recipients must enroll for a minimum of six credits during the term of the award, and are encouraged to assist other students as math tutors.

MARION LEVY SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships, of varying amounts, are awarded to students who have demonstrated academic excellence. Preference is given to students enrolled in a nursing curriculum at Westchester Community College.

LIM EBON & TAN LE ENG SCHOLARSHIP

An award of \$400 is available to a student enrolled in a mathematics, engineering or physical sciences curriculum who has completed at least 24 credits with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better. The recipient must enroll for a minimum of six credits during the term of the award, and is encouraged to assist other students as a math tutor.

MADLINE MCFADDEN MEMORIAL NURSING AWARD

This award remembers the long and distinguished career of a consummate nurse, teacher, and mentor. It is presented to a student in either the Advanced Nursing Degree or Practical Nursing programs at Westchester Community College to help him or her meet expenses above and beyond tuition and complete the degree program. Nursing employees of Westchester County Medical Center or The Ruth Taylor Institute are encouraged to apply.

N. ANNE MCKIERNAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 award was established by family and friends in honor of a dedicated nurse and administrator of the Behavioral Health Center of the Westchester Medical Center. It is presented to a female student in her second year who is enrolled in the Advanced Nursing Degree program at Westchester Community College. Preference is given to students who have demonstrated an interest in Behavioral Psychology.

ORGANIZATION OF CHINESE-AMERICANS ASIAN STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The local chapter of the national OCA offers this award to a student of Asian descent who has achieved a minimum GPA of 3.0 after completing at least 12 credits and enrolls for a minimum of six credits during the term of the award. The recipient should demonstrate an interest in promoting or learning about the cultures of the region.

***CARLOS DEL REY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

In memory of Professor Emeritus Carlos del Rey, the founder of El Club Hispano-Americano, this \$250 award is given to an active member of E.C.H.A. who has demonstrated outstanding contributions and commitment to the club. Inquire at El Club Hispano-Americano.

***THE RICE FAMILY FOUNDATION NURSING AWARDS**

These scholarships are awarded to nursing students entering the LPN Certificate Program at Westchester Community College (three per year at \$2,000 each) and nursing students in their second year of the ADN Program (seven per year at \$2,000 each).

THE RICE FAMILY FOUNDATION TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIPS

A number of scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000 per year are awarded to students who have demonstrated academic excellence in technology or computer-related curricula.

RICHARD & BETH RODRIGUEZ SCHOLARSHIP

This award is presented to a Hispanic or Latino/a student, who demonstrates academic achievement and financial need. This award is made possible through the generosity of Westchester Community College faculty member Richard Rodriguez and his wife Beth.

MICHAEL ROVELLO PUBLIC SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Based on scholastic achievement and good citizenship, \$500 is awarded to a student entering his/her final year or semester at Westchester Community College. Ideally the recipient should be majoring in a social science and intending to pursue a career in public service.

RUSSELL RETENTION RESOURCES FUND

Established by Theodora L. Russell in honor of her late husband, Eugene E. Russell, this award assists students who have serious financial problems. The award is made only after the student has successfully completed a portion of his/her studies at Westchester Community College and may be forced to drop out because of external financial reasons.

THEODORA AND EUGENE E. RUSSELL SCHOLARSHIPS

A number of scholarships of varying amounts are awarded to second-year students who exhibit both merit and need. The fund was established by a bequest from Theodora L. Russell, a Director of The Westchester Community College Foundation.

CAROL AND DORLAND RUSSETT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are presented to outstanding female students who wish to continue their education at the College, in order to assist them in achieving their full potential as professionals. This award remembers Dr. Russett and her forty-one years at the college as a student, staff member, professor and administrator; as well as her husband Dorland, a staunch supporter of the college's scholarship program up until his death, when he left the college funds to permanently endow a scholarship.

SAMBERG FAMILY SCHOLARSHIPS

Several awards of varying amounts are presented to outstanding continuing students who demonstrate financial need.

EMMA & WALTER SCHARF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established by family and friends, this award is presented annually to a student enrolled in a nursing, culinary arts and management, or dietetic technician program. The student must have completed at least 12 credits, and shown dedication and passion in his or her field of interest.

RUTH AND JEROME SIEGEL SCHOLARSHIPS

Two scholarships are awarded to outstanding students enrolled in a business curriculum. To be eligible, students must be entering their second year at the college, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and demonstrate service and financial need.

SKIRBALL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards of varying amounts are presented to students who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement, service and financial need.

LINDA CHING SLEDGE FUTURE EDUCATORS' SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is named for Dr. Sledge, professor emerita and faculty founder of the campus chapter of the Future Educators Association. Established by family and colleagues in 2006 upon Dr. Sledge's retirement, this award honors her thirty-two years at the college as a teacher, scholars and writer of fiction.

STADLER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIPS

Several scholarships, of varying amounts, are presented to outstanding continuing students who demonstrate financial need.

STOP & SHOP COMPANIES SCHOLARSHIPS

Two scholarships are awarded to second-year students enrolled in a Business-related or Food Service curriculum. Perhaps as important as a good academic record, the recipient will have demonstrated enthusiasm, dedication and leadership in their field or college activities. The recipients may be selected from nominations made by the chairperson of the above-noted curriculum areas.

STUDENT SCHOLAR AWARDS

These scholarships of \$2,500 each are presented to outstanding continuing students who have completed at least 15 credits at Westchester Community College and have attained an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Scholarships are named for the donors:

SUNY EMPIRE STATE DIVERSITY HONORS SCHOLARSHIPS

Supported by a grant from New York State, with matching funds from the Mary & James G. Wallach Foundation, these \$1000 awards are given to outstanding students from diverse backgrounds and ethnicities. With a contribution of \$10,000 that provided matching funds for the SUNY Diversity Honors program, the Wallach Foundation made possible twenty scholarships in 2006-2007.

DAVID SWOPE SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are presented to outstanding students who demonstrate financial need. The award is made possible through the generosity of Westchester Community College Foundation President David Swope.

WALTER VAN WERTH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

An award of \$400 is presented to a second-year student who has demonstrated high academic achievement in Marketing Management or other business-related curriculum.

WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to a continuing student, who is preferably a Westchester county resident at the time of application and/or the son/daughter of an alumnus/a. The student must have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement, and shown perseverance, volunteerism and leadership to the college and outside community.

WESTCHESTER FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS SCHOLARSHIPS

These partial scholarships, based on academic achievement and financial need, are awarded to female students who are continuing at Westchester Community College in Liberal Arts, Music or Fine Arts.

***WESTCHESTER COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF TOWN SUPERINTENDENTS OF HIGHWAYS AWARDS**

Three awards, ranging from \$250 to \$500, are awarded to full and part-time students having a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Recipients must be residents of Westchester County and enrolled in the Civil Technology program.

JESPER WOODLEY MEMORIAL MATHEMATICS SCHOLARSHIP

In memory of Jesper Woodley, a Westchester Community College graduate, this \$500 award is made to a second-year student who shows special promise in mathematics, a dedication to ethics, and a desire to help fellow students.

DAVID WRAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award is presented to a part-time continuing student enrolled in the early childhood curriculum, who is either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and who demonstrates academic potential and financial need.

FRED WRIGHT SCHOLARSHIP

Established by this former Foundation Board member, scholarships of \$500 each are available for sons or daughters of active members of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers. These students must be attending Westchester Community College. If no applications are received from relatives of members of the I.B.E.W., other students will be considered.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NEW OR CONTINUING STUDENTS

WILLIAM P. DAWSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In memory of the man who was instrumental in the development of Emergency Medical Service in Westchester County, a \$500 scholarship is awarded to either a new or continuing student who is enrolled in the Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic curriculum at Westchester Community College.

SHIRLEY DURST SCHOLARSHIPS

Several scholarships of varying amounts are presented to students who have demonstrated academic excellence and who wish to begin their education at Westchester Community College, or who require assistance to continue in the nursing program.

A & J ECONOMOS SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are presented to new or continuing students who have demonstrated academic excellence, financial need and service to the College or community. Continuing students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0. New students must have shown promise while in high school.

THE FRIENDS OF WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE AWARD

In honor of the Friends, the Foundation awards this \$500 scholarship to a student who has demonstrated overall academic achievement and leadership qualities and has financial need.

LISA MANCHER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Mancher Family Foundation makes this award as a memorial to the remarkable life of Lisa Mancher who, despite multiple physical disabilities, received a Bachelor's degree, was on her way toward completing a Master's, and held a job. The scholarship is awarded to a disabled student in need of financial aid to begin or complete his/her education at Westchester Community College.

EDWIN G. MICHAELIAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Westchester Community College Foundation offers a scholarship to a high school graduate in Westchester County who is in the top quarter of his/her class, has demonstrated exceptional leadership qualities and plans to attend Westchester Community College. The award may also be given to a continuing student with an excellent academic record and leadership qualities. The award amount is \$500 per semester.

KATE CROMWELL MOORE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are presented to new and continuing students with disabilities who achieve academic excellence and who demonstrate financial need.

KATHERINE & DAVID MOORE GATEWAY SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are presented to outstanding matriculated immigrant students who demonstrate academic excellence and financial need. The fund also provides support to students in the intensive and semi-intensive English as a Second Language programs at Westchester Community College.

ST. JOSEPH'S MEDICAL CENTER SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are offered to students in the LPN of ADN nursing programs at Westchester Community College. Recipients are committed to working for a period of one year after graduation.

***THE HENRY HART RICE DAY CARE GRANTS**

Given by the Rice Family on the occasion of Mr. Rice's eightieth birthday, these grants in varying amounts support students using the services of the Virginia Marx Children's Center. Inquire at the Children's Center.

SOUND FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN SCHOLARSHIPS

Two scholarships of \$500 each are provided by Sound Federal Savings and Loan Charitable Association for the general support of students enrolled in a business curriculum.

UNISYS CORPORATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Two scholarships of \$500 each are awarded to students who have demonstrated competence in computer-related curricula.

JULIUS WEISS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$500 awards, created by the Heckscher Foundation for Children in memory of this former Westchester Community College Foundation Board member, are given to deserving Westchester Community College students under the age of twenty-one, or those who plan to pursue a career that involves working with children.

***WESTCHESTER ART WORKSHOP AWARDS**

A variety of awards, including some specifically for students with disabilities, are available. Inquire at the Westchester Art Workshop.

WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are awarded to incoming high school graduates who are in the top quarter of their class and have demonstrated leadership qualities. The Foundation also offers scholarships to continuing students who have achieved academic success. Preference will be given to those who have financial need, have provided service to the College or community, or have surmounted unusual or difficult circumstances.

ROBERT & SHERRY WIENER SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships ranging from \$500 per semester to \$2,500 per year are awarded to new or continuing students who have demonstrated high academic achievement or potential for success. Other factors to be considered are financial need, service to the College or community, or difficult circumstances the applicant has to overcome.

WORLD TRADE CENTER SCHOLARSHIPS

These awards are presented to students rebuilding lives after the World Trade Center disaster in 2001. The scholarships were made possible through a grant from the NYSBA Research & Education Foundation in Albany, N.Y.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS FOR GRADUATING STUDENTS

(Those students who obtain a degree from Westchester Community College in August, December or May.)

Some awards, related to specific curriculum areas or college service, are determined by other college departments or committees and may have a special application form and determination process. These awards are designated by an asterisk (*). Inquire at the particular department or the Foundation office.

ALPHA BETA GAMMA AWARDS

A scholarship fund created by members of the local Delta chapter of Alpha Beta Gamma, a national business honor society, provides scholarships to outstanding graduating students in various eligible curricula. Awards are \$100 each.

JOHN F.X. AMBROSE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship, in memory of a former Registrar, will be presented to a Westchester Community College student who has an above average scholastic record, has given outstanding service to the college community and has a commitment to continue his/her education at a four year college.

AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$500 awards are presented at graduation to female students who have been accepted at four-year colleges. They must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher and have demonstrated leadership qualities and concern for women's issues. The award is funded by the Westchester branch of the A.A.U.W.

ANNA J. BERNARD TRUSTEE AWARD

This award of \$300 is presented annually to a black student upon graduation from Westchester Community College. The recipient must be a resident of Westchester County who is transferring to a four-year institution, must have given outstanding service to the college and present an excellent academic record.

WALTER BREEDE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 award perpetuates the memory of Walter Breede, Jr., a good friend of Westchester Community College and a dedicated language student. The award is presented at graduation to a student who has been accepted at a four-year institution and who has demonstrated proficiency in at least one modern language and in English, and who best exemplifies excellence, perseverance, sensitivity and cooperation in the pursuit of his/her academic and personal goals.

DAVID B. AND LOUIS F. CHISHOLM SCHOLARSHIP

Two awards of \$400 each are presented at commencement to graduating students who show the most all-around achievement in scholarship, character, and civic responsibility, and plan to continue their education at a four-year institution.

MARY A. CHRISTESEN MEMORIAL AWARD

ROBERT J. CONDON SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship, in memory of a former professor of Westchester Community College, is given to an outstanding graduating student who is majoring in Accounting or Computer Information Systems.

MARSHALL AND HELEN COOKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established by Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Keyes, \$250 is awarded to a deserving student selected by the President of the college.

JAMES DADAKIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In memory of his dedication to teaching and his devotion to his studies, a \$250 scholarship is awarded each year to an outstanding physics or engineering science graduating student.

ALFRED B. DELBELLO SCHOLARSHIP

\$1000 is presented at commencement to one or two full-time students who are residents of Westchester County. Its purpose is to enable the student to continue at Westchester Community College or transfer to a four-year institution.

VERA DELGROSSO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

This annual award of \$1000 is given by the college family, in memory of Vera Delgrosso, to an outstanding graduating student who plans to attend a four-year college, has demonstrated academic achievement, and outstanding service to the college.

HAROLD L. DRIMMER SCHOLARSHIP

In honor of the distinguished former chairman of the Westchester Community College Board of Trustees, an award of \$500 is made annually by the Westchester Community College Foundation to an outstanding Westchester Community College graduate with financial need who plans to continue his/her higher education.

FACULTY/STUDENT ASSOCIATION PEPSI SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 is awarded to a student who demonstrates academic excellence and has shown significant contributions to student life activities at Westchester Community College. An additional contribution from Pepsi of \$9,000 annually for ten years will be reserved in an endowed fund to support this award in the future.

JEFFREY A. FISCHMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

In memory of Mr. Fischman's dedication to the teaching profession, \$200 is awarded to a graduating student who plans to pursue a career in education that involves working directly with children.

LETTY FISHER MEMORIAL AWARDS

These awards are presented to outstanding graduates of the retail management program.

JOSEPH T. FOSTER MEMORIAL AWARD

In honor of a distinguished member of the business department, a \$100 award is given to the business studies graduating student with the highest GPA and is funded through contributions from alumni, family, friends, and associates.

PROF. STEPHEN J. FRIEDMAN MEMORIAL HISTORY AWARD

One or two awards of at least \$600 each will be given to graduating students who have demonstrated an interest and excellence in history courses taken at Westchester Community College. The recipient(s) should have taken at least three history courses and received a grade of A in two of them. Recipients must intend to continue their education beyond Westchester Community College and should indicate a desire to expand their knowledge of history.

ANNE MARIE GLATZEL MEMORIAL AWARD

In memory of this distinguished office technologies professor, \$100 is awarded to the graduating student in that curriculum who best exemplifies the character traits of appropriate business attitudes, professionalism, and scholarship and who will pursue further education.

ARTHUR JAMES HACKETT SCHOLARSHIP

\$1500 is awarded annually to a student graduating from either Engineering Science or Engineering Technologies who plans to continue his/her education in Engineering or Technology.

DR. JOSEPH N. HANKIN PUBLIC SPEAKING AWARD

This book award is given to two graduating students who have demonstrated excellence in public speaking and who have excelled in the Communication and Media Arts curriculum.

LEONARD A. HARPER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a graduate of the Educational Opportunity Center with a B average or better, who has been accepted at a college to continue his or her education, and has financial need.

MELVIN HERMAN HUMAN SERVICE MEMORIAL AWARD

Established by Professor Pauline Herman in memory of her husband, \$100 is presented at commencement to a graduating student in human services who plans to continue his/her education.

INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS AWARD

A diploma of achievement and a cash award are given to a student in Electrical Technology who is academically outstanding and has contributed to the IEEE Chapter at Westchester Community College and to the Electrical Technology curriculum.

ITALIAN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

A \$200 scholarship is awarded to an outstanding student of Italian who is graduating from the college and who has been an active member and/or officer of the Italian Club.

ANDREW JOERG MEMORIAL AWARD

Professor Ernest Joerg, in memory of his father, provides two texts of major importance to an outstanding graduating student in the Electrical Technology curriculum who plans to continue his/her education in a four-year electrical or mechanical technology program.

JOHANNA EVA JOERG ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

\$50 is given annually to an outstanding female student in Electrical Technology or Engineering Science majoring in Electrical Engineering or the Electronics certificate program. She must achieve a GPA of 3.0 or better.

MARTIN LUTHER KING AWARD

\$500 is awarded by The Foundation for Westchester Community College to a graduating minority student with an overall cumulative average of 3.0 or better. Criteria include good character, leadership qualities and evidence of outstanding service in promoting racial brotherhood.

JOHN A. KLEY VALEDICTORIAN AWARD

In honor of this former Foundation Board member, \$500 is awarded annually by The Foundation for Westchester Community College to the selected valedictorian.

PHILIP C. MARTIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In honor of the College's first president, \$200 is presented to a graduate who is the son, daughter, spouse, or parent of an alumnus/alumna.

NEW YORK STATE SOCIETY OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS, WESTCHESTER COUNTY CHAPTER AWARD

A \$1000 scholarship is awarded to the outstanding Engineering Technology graduating student planning to pursue an engineering career. The award is based on scholastic achievement, potential and need. The scholarship is to be paid to the engineering school of the student's choice.

LAWRENCE NUGENT MEMORIAL AWARD

\$400 is awarded to a graduating student who is actively involved in student government, has a high grade point average, and plans to continue his/her education at a four-year institution.

PEPSICO COMMUNICATIONS AND MEDIA ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

This \$2000 scholarship donated by PepsiCo is awarded to deserving students who have demonstrated academic excellence in the curriculum and have made outstanding contributions to the college in the area of communications.

The chapter of Phi Theta Kappa, Alpha Iota Omicron presents one or more scholarships to deserving students who are members of Phi Theta Kappa and who intend to continue their education at a four-year college or university. The recipient(s) will have demonstrated the ideals of scholarship, service and perseverance that Gene Leon epitomized as a student at Westchester Community College.

NAT A. POLITO MEMORIAL AWARD

An award of \$25 is given to the outstanding Electronics certificate graduate based on academic achievement and participation in Electrical Society activities.

JOYCE POZSAR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established by family and colleagues in memory of Ms. Pozsar, a manager of the Westchester Community College Bookstore, this scholarship of \$400 recognizes a female student who has an excellent academic record and seeks to further her education in a professional field.

CARMINE L. ROMANO MEMORIAL AWARD

The family, friends, colleagues and students of the late Professor Romano have established this memorial in his name. An award of \$350 is given each year at commencement to an outstanding graduating Accounting student.

A \$100 bond is presented by the Student Senate to the class salutatorian.

GEORGE SANDS AWARD

WILLIAM SNYDER MEMORIAL AWARD

This award was established by Consumers Union, publisher of Consumer Reports, in honor of Bill Snyder, CU engineer and former Westchester Community College faculty member, who devoted his career to protecting consumers by testing products for safety. The recipient shall be a graduating student in Auto Technology who has demonstrated a commitment to competence and integrity in providing service to consumers.

JULIUS WEISS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$500 awards, created by the Heckscher Foundation for Children in memory of this former Westchester Community College Foundation Board member, are given to deserving Westchester Community College students under the age of twenty-one, or those who plan to pursue a career that involves working with children.

WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Several awards of \$500 each are made to outstanding graduates who have been accepted to a four-year institution.

WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION SPECIAL INCENTIVE AWARDS

An award of \$500 is given to graduating students who complete their education while coping with a unique situation or unusual difficulties.

WESTCHESTER COUNTY CHAPTER OF LINKS SCHOLARSHIP

A \$300 scholarship is awarded to a graduating black woman who has been accepted in a human services oriented program at a four-year institution.

*WESTCHESTER/ROCKLAND CHAPTER OF THE NEW YORK STATE RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500 scholarship is presented each year to a student in the Food Service Administration: Restaurant Management Program. The award is based on academic achievement, financial need, and involvement in College and community hospitality events.

SCHOLARSHIPS TO FOUR-YEAR COLLEGES

All applicants for scholarships to four-year colleges must have earned an associate degree, have applied and been accepted to one of the colleges listed to be eligible for scholarships. BENNINGTON COLLEGE B.A./M.A IN TEACHING FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGE GRADUATES SCHOLARSHIPS

(Located in Bennington, Vermont)

Bennington College offers scholarships of \$20,000 per year for two years and a proportional amount for the graduate year. To be eligible for this program, a candidate must be nominated, have demonstrated academic achievement (with a minimum GPA of 3.0), show potential to thrive in a liberal arts environment, and have a desire to pursue a career in teaching.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY PHI THETA KAPPA AWARD

Phi Theta Kappa chapter advisors are invited to nominate students for these awards. Advisors may submit up to two nominations. A minimum 3.5 GPA and 60 transferable credit hours are required.

CLARKSON UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLAR AWARD

This award is presented to an outstanding scholar in Business Administration and provides up to \$8,000 towards tuition and expenses at Clarkson University, Located in Potsdam, New York.

COLLEGE OF MOUNT SAINT VINCENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic scholarships are available to eligible Westchester Community College transfers who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0-3.5 (\$4,500), or 3.5 or better (\$6,500). The graduate with the highest cumulative GPA of all Westchester Community College applicants to CMSV is eligible for a \$10,000/year academic scholarship (awarded for spring and fall semesters). Westchester Community College graduates with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, who have demonstrated great leadership through outstanding service and activities at Westchester Community College are eligible for the ELIZABETH SETON SERVICE AWARD of approximately \$1,000.

COLLEGE OF NEW ROCHELLE SCHOLARSHIP

The College of New Rochelle offers Transfer Scholarships ranging from \$2,500 to full tuition. Students who have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher are eligible for a Transfer Scholarship. In addition, scholarship recipients are invited

to apply to the Honors Program. CNR also offers several scholarships of \$1,000 to potential Westchester Community College transfers.

COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF GENERAL STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP

Up to three \$6,000 New Student Incentive Scholarships per academic year are reserved specifically for applicants from Westchester Community College. In order to be considered, Westchester Community College applicants must have at least 56 transferable credits, at least a 3.60 cumulative GPA and plan to enroll full-time (12 credits or more).

C.W. POST CAMPUS OF LONG ISLAND UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

C.W. Post offers renewable transfer scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$10,000 per year. Scholarships are based on cumulative grade point averages. A cumulative average of 3.0 to 3.24 earns a \$2,000 scholarship; 3.25 to 3.74 earns \$3,000; 3.75 or better earns \$6,000. Students accepted into the Honors Program are eligible for additional awards of up to \$2,000. A limited number of \$10,000 scholarships, renewable for up to two years, are also awarded to full time students transferring with an Associate's Degree (AS or AA) and a cumulative grade point average of 3.9 or better.

DOMINICAN COLLEGE OF BLAUVELT SCHOLARSHIP

Transfer Scholarships ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000 are available to students with a minimum GPA of 3.5 or better who apply for full-time study. A full-tuition scholarship is awarded to a Human Service graduate. Part-time scholarships are available on a per-credit basis. Scholarships are renewable, based on maintenance of a 3.0 overall GPA. A-fixed-rate tuition is in place for students maintaining a consecutive 12-credit course-load.

HOFSTRA UNIVERSITY TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP

A \$7,000 renewable scholarship awarded to two students with 4.0 GPAs. Academic Honors Transfer Scholarships (a baseline of \$2,000, which may be subject to incremental increases, depending upon a student's GPA and financial need.) may also be awarded to incoming transfer students who have earned a minimum of 24 credit hours from accredited institutions with a 3.0 cumulative GPA or better at all previously attended institutions. Possible amounts of \$4,000 per year with 3.5 GPA or greater, or \$2,000 per year with a 3.0 to 3.49 GPA are available.

In addition, incoming part-time day or evening students who have demonstrated academic ability and need may also be awarded a scholarship. Possible Amounts of \$1,000 - \$2,000.

Phi Theta Kappa Awards are given to students who hold membership in Phi Theta Kappa and who meet the established requirements of a 3.5 GPA with 58 credit hours upon entry to the university.

IONA COLLEGE AWARD

One full-tuition day scholarship (less state aid) is awarded to the graduate of Westchester Community College with the highest grade-point average in a business curriculum. Additionally, merit scholarships range from \$3,000-\$7,000, based on GPA.

MANHATTAN COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Manhattan College will award one Westchester Community College academic scholarship valued at \$10,000 per year and renew-able for a second year. In addition, graduates of any program at Westchester having an articulation agreement with Manhattan are eligible for a Manhattan College Presidential Scholarship ranging from \$3,000 to \$8,000 per year based on a GPA of 3.4 or higher.

MANHATTANVILLE COLLEGE – WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Students from Westchester Community College are eligible for the following scholarships for full-time undergraduate admissions at Manhattanville College: cumulative average of 2.5 or better will receive a \$4,000 scholarship each year, 3.0 or better will receive \$6,000 each year. A cumulative of 3.5 or better will receive \$7,500 each year. In addition, Manhattanville also offers The Manhattanville-Westchester Community College Scholarship for \$10,000. To qualify the student must have obtained an Associate's Degree from Westchester Community College and maintained a cumulative average of 3.8 or better. Student must also continue at Manhattanville on a full-time status.

MARYMOUNT COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Marymount College offers a number of scholarships to Westchester Community College transfer students. They include:

Trustee Scholarship:

These scholarships are determined by graduates' GPA at Westchester Community College and range in value from \$2,000 to \$10,000.

Book Scholarship:

A book scholarship will be awarded to one out-standing transfer student from Westchester Community College each year. This scholarship is \$500 (\$250 per semester).

Westchester Community College Honors Scholars Scholarship:

Transfer students from the Honors Program at Westchester Community College will be designated as Westchester Community College Honors Scholars. These students will be awarded \$1,500 in addition to any other scholarships they may receive provided that:

- 1. They are certified graduates of the Honors Program, with a minimum of four honors courses.*
- 2. They have earned a minimum 3.5 GPA at Westchester Community College.*
- 3. They have been accepted by Marymount College as a full-time student.*

MERCY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

A full-tuition scholarship is awarded annually to an outstanding scholar in Business Administration who has maintained a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 at Westchester Community College. Honor student graduates with a minimum GPA of 3.2 are eligible for minimum half tuition scholarships.

General Mercy College Transfer Scholarships are available for students with a 3.2 minimum GPA. Scholarships are available for full or part-time study and are based upon academic merit and need. All scholarships are renewable based upon continuing academic excellence.

NYU SCHOOL OF EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

NYU Community College Transfer Opportunity Program (CCTOP) Majors include Education, Communication Studies, Applied Psychology, Nursing, Nutrition, Art and Music. Full-time CCTOP students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher receive a minimum merit-based scholarship ranging from \$8,000 to \$13,000 for each year of study at NYU. Additional need-based scholarships are also available.

PACE UNIVERSITY: EDWIN G. MICHAELIAN SCHOLARSHIP

Two annual scholarships are awarded to a graduating student who wishes to study in the Lubin School of Business and a graduating student who wishes to study in the Dyson College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Pace University. Each award is for a minimum of \$500 (up to full tuition if there is financial need).

SACRED HEART UNIVERSITY AWARD

Sacred Heart University awards the Westchester Community College Transfer Achievement Award. Students with a cumulative GPA over 3.20 will be eligible for this program.

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship: Prospective transfer students who are elected members of the Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society are eligible for this scholarship. In order to be eligible, students must have a 3.5 cumulative G.P.A. at the time of application to receive a scholarship of \$4,500 for one full year.

SARAH LAWRENCE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

The Sarah Lawrence College Center for Continuing Education offers a full tuition scholarship to one graduate of the Westchester Community College Early Childhood Program each year. This need-based scholarship covers all tuition, fees and book expenses through completion of the BA as long as the recipient remains eligible for financial aid and is in good academic standing. The total value of the scholarship can be as much as \$45,000. The process includes a personal interview, a written application and a financial aid application, all of which must be completed by April 15.

The Center for Continuing Education also offers Sarah Lawrence College Scholarships to eligible adult students from all programs at Westchester Community College. These scholarships generally cover 45-50% of the cost of tuition fees and books. Applications for scholarship aid are accepted throughout the year, but early application is recommended to assure the most generous possible scholarship.

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK COLLEGE AT PURCHASE SCHOLARSHIP

Two scholarships (Liberal Arts & Sciences and Visual Arts) are awarded for \$1,500 per year based on merit; 3 additional awards are offered in cooperation with the Westchester Community College Foundation for up to \$3,000 per year. Purchase also offers additional scholarships to transfer students based on merit as well as merit and need; the average award for these is \$10,000 per year.

SUNY BROCKPORT SCHOLARSHIP

Presidential Scholars in Residence programs for transfer students with a minimum 3.8 GPA. Each Presidential Scholar in Residence will receive a room waiver for the year, which may be renewed for a second year.

SUNY PLATTSBURGH SCHOLARSHIP

The SUNY Plattsburgh Scholarship is awarded to students, based on GPA as follows:

3.7 GPA... \$1,500 Transfer Excellence Scholarship

3.3 GPA... \$1,000 Transfer Merit Scholarship

3.0 GPA... \$500 Transfer Achievement Scholarship

THE COLLEGE OF INSURANCE SCHOLARSHIP

Academic Scholarships are available to eligible transfer students from Westchester Community College. These academic scholarships range from \$5,000 to \$10,000 annually and are dependent on a GPA of 3.0 or better.

UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI SCHOLARSHIP

Academic scholarships are available to eligible Westchester Community College graduates who have a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher. Scholarships range from \$5,400 to \$10,500 annually, depending upon GPA.

UNIVERSITY OF ROCHESTER MELIORA TRANSFER GRANT

Graduating students who complete either the Liberal Arts/Humanities Program or the Honors Program and have a GPA of 3.0 or better will be guaranteed admission to the University of Rochester and automatically will qualify for the Meliora Transfer Grant (up to full tuition). The application fee is waived. Members of Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society are also eligible for an additional \$5,000 scholarship

Special Programs

BRIDGES TO THE BACCALAUREATE PROGRAM

The National Institutes of Health sponsors this program between SUNY/Binghamton and Westchester Community College. Underrepresented minority students receive special benefits while they pursue their studies in the sciences and math. These students continue to receive support when they go on to Binghamton to pursue a baccalaureate degree in a biomedical field. For more information, contact Dean Calvin Johnson – 914-785-6912

STUDY/VOLUNTEER ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP:

Established by Marcy Berlin, Coordinator of Transfer Services. This scholarship of varying amounts, is awarded to a Westchester Community College student in good standing who is interested in studying or volunteering abroad (including summer). May be presented to a new, continuing or graduating student.

VASSAR COLLEGE EXPLORING TRANSFER SUMMER PROGRAMS

For Westchester Community College students who have completed a minimum of 18 credits. This 5-week residential program is designed to expand the transfer options of community college students by introducing them to a four-year liberal arts college experience. Students take two intensive, intellectually challenging liberal arts courses at Vassar, which are team taught by faculty members at Vassar and participating community colleges. The fully funded program is particularly interested in enrolling students from minority and low-income family backgrounds who are underrepresented in selective residential private colleges. See Professor Gwen Roundtree for more information and application.


