Trustee Robeson Smith reported:

Resolution: In-State Tuition for Students from Countries with Temporary Protected Status

WHEREAS, SUNY has a history of responding to populations in need by designating the citizens/residents of locations devastated by natural or manmade disasters as New York residents for tuition purposes; and

WHEREAS, the United States Secretary for the Department of Homeland Security is authorized to designate a foreign state (or any part thereof) for Temporary Protected Status upon finding that extraordinary and temporary conditions in the foreign state prevent its nationals from returning safely; and

WHEREAS, the SUNY Board of Trustees wishes to extend the benefit of resident tuition to students who are nationals of countries that have been designated with Temporary Protected Status as a humanitarian response which acknowledges these students' inability to return to their home; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2022, the SUNY Board of Trustees adopted a resolution authorizing the SUNY Chancellor or designee, to amend the SUNY guidelines governing residency for tuition purposes to make undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in

the State- operated institutions of the State University of New York, who are attending these institutions on non-immigrant visas and are nationals of a country that has been granted Temporary Protected Status, to be considered eligible for resident tuition for the 2022/23 academic year; and,

WHEREAS, the resolution encouraged the boards of trustees of the thirty {30} community colleges operating under the program of SUNY, to take similar action or to otherwise provide assistance and support to facilitate the ability of these students to continue their academic studies at SUNY; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Westchester Community College hereby authorizes students who are nationals of countries that have been granted Temporary Protected Status, such designated countries currently including Afghanistan, Burma (Myanmar), Cameroon, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Haiti, Honduras, Nepal, Nicaragua, Syria, Somalia, Sudan, South Sudan, Ukraine, Venezuela, and Yemen, to be considered eligible for resident tuition for the 2022/23 academic year in accordance with the amended SUNY guidelines governing residency for tuition purposes.
