RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE POLICY FOR BOARD MEETING PARTICIPATION VIA VIDEOCONFERENCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees had previously established a policy for board meeting participation via videoconference; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees reviewed the new state requirements and updated its policy to allow board members to participate remotely in extenuating circumstances in accordance with the law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees hereby approves the amendment to the policy for Board Meeting Participation via Videoconference.
