Profile of the Graduates and Graduate Survey Analysis



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The 2020-2021 Graduate Report

The **2020-2021 Graduate Report** provides information about the 2020-2021 graduating class of Westchester Community College in two ways. First, it compares the demographics of the graduating class to those students who responded to the 2020-2021 Graduate Survey in the **Profile of the 2020-2021 Graduates**. Second, it examines the responses of the 2020-2021 Graduate Survey in the **2020-2021 Graduate Survey Analysis**.


Methodology

The 2020-2021 Graduate Report examines the 1,767 students who graduated from Westchester Community College in Summer 2020, Fall 2020, and Spring 2021, otherwise considered the graduating class of 2021. Six months after the students graduated, they were sent an online survey regarding their time at WCC as well as their experiences after graduation. The online survey was left open for 3 months before the results were downloaded. This resulted in 348 completed surveys and a response rate of 19.7%. The survey results were merged with institutional data to provide insight into the representativeness of the survey respondents.


Profile of the 2020-2021 Graduating Class

The Profile of the 2020-2021 Graduating Class uses institutional data to identify the demographic and academic attributes of the graduating class of 2021. This includes gender, race/ethnicity, age, residence, GPA, and degree type. These attributes are compared to the subset of graduates who responded to the Graduate Survey to ensure the survey responses can be generalized to the entire graduating class.


Gender: The gender distribution for survey respondents and graduates were similar with female students outnumbering males in both categories. Additionally, females were more likely to have completed the survey than males.




Race/Ethnicity: Hispanic/Latino (43.1%) and White (29.2%) students made up the largest shares of graduates. These groups also made up the largest numbers of survey respondents, with 133 Hispanic/Latino (38.2%) and 100 White (28.7%) students, respectively.




Age: Approximately 33 percent of survey respondents (113 of 328 students) and 41 percent of graduates (728 of 1,767 students) fell within the 21 to 24 age range. It is important to note that those in this category responded at a lower rate than their relative percentage among the graduates.




Residence: Of the 1,767 students who made up the graduating class of 2021, 1,395 (78.9%) resided in Westchester County. A similar percentage of respondents (77.6%) also reported living in Westchester County. Very few respondents (0.9%) and graduates (1.2%) lived outside of New York State at the time they responded to the survey.



GPA: The largest GPA category of degrees completed by graduates was between 3.01 and 3.50 (33.6%). However, the largest category among the survey respondents was those with GPAs between 3.51-4.00 (43.0%).



Degree Type: Among survey respondents, there were similar numbers of those obtaining A.A. (30.6%), A.A.S (32.0%), and A.S. (33.1%) degrees. Certificates made up less than 6 percent of the credentials granted to both survey respondents and graduates. The percentages of respondents were well representative of those of the graduates within these programs.




2020-2021 Graduate Survey Analysis


The 2020-2021 Graduate Survey Analysis examines the responses to various questions from the Graduate Survey. The following data are self-reported and cannot be verified. Students who did not provide a response were omitted from the analysis.

Student Satisfaction


Satisfaction with WCC in Achieving Goals: Students were satisfied or very satisfied with WCC, particularly in regard to helping them achieve their personal (96.3%) and academic goals (95.9%). Students were slightly less satisfied with the college in aiding them in attaining their career (86.5%) and their social goals (83.6%).




Satisfaction with Overall WCC Experience: The overall satisfaction with the WCC experience was relatively high across each survey question. Over 96 percent of students were *satisfied* or *very satisfied* with the overall quality of instruction. They reported similar percentages of satisfaction with their overall college experience (94.8%), and courses both in their major (93.4%) and outside their major (92.1%).



Satisfaction with WCC Experience: Respondents were most satisfied with WCC aiding them in increasing their knowledge and understanding (97.8%), followed by developing their skills in expressing themselves both orally (92.2%), and in writing (94.8%). Students felt less satisfied with the social climate (84.7%) and transferring to a four year institution (84.9%).




Satisfaction with WCC Services: Survey respondents rated WCC services favorably. Specifically, students were either *somewhat satisfied* or *very satisfied* with Disability Services (98.3%), and the Children's Center (98.0%), Computer Services/Labs (97.4%), and Library (97.5%). A slightly lower percentage of students were satisfied with Transfer Services (81.0%), Financial Aid (81.7%), and Scholarships (81.7%).




Educational Goals


Are you currently attending a college, university, or training program?: Fifty-five percent of survey respondents (190 of 348 students) were attending a four year college or university when they responded to the survey.




Are you attending a college, university, or training program full-time or part-time?: Eighty-one percent of students reported attending their current educational program full-time (177 of 220 students).



Where is your college, university, or training program located?: Fifty-eight percent of the respondents were attending schools or programs in New York State but outside of Westchester County (98 of 169 students). Fewer than ten percent of respondents were attending schools outside of New York State.




To what extent do you feel WCC prepared you for further study?: More than 76 percent of respondents (129 of 169) felt well prepared for their educational goals after graduating from WCC.



Career Goals

What is your employment status?: Twenty-seven percent were employed, either full- or part-time, in a job related to their degree/certificate (71 of 268) compared to 42 percent (113 of 268) who reported careers unrelated to their training. More than 16 percent of the respondents (44 of 268) were not employed, but were seeking employment.



Is this your first professional position obtained after earning your degree?: More than 64 percent of students (116 of 180) indicated that their current job was not the first one they obtained after earning their degree.




Where is your employer located?: Sixty percent of the respondents (107 of 179) were employed within Westchester County. Fewer than 12 percent were employed outside New York State (20 of 179).




What is your current salary range?: More than 42 percent of the respondents (73 of 173) reported earning below \$30,000 a year in their current profession. Forty percent earned \$40,000 or more (69 of 173).



To what extent did WCC prepare you for your current job?: Seventy-one (124 of 175) percent of survey respondents felt that their experiences at WCC enabled them to be *well prepared* or *somewhat prepared* for their current job (124 of 175).



Are you satisfied with your current job?: Over three-quarters of the respondents were either *very* satisfied or satisfied with their current job (134 of 177 respondents).



Conclusion

The information presented above can be used by the faculty, staff, and administrators of the College to identify areas for improvement. It can be a valuable tool for assessment of academic programs, college services, and college processes, and can provide a starting point for future analyses.


