FALL 2020 COHORT

Under the guidelines set forth by the federal *Student Right to Know Act*, the graduation rate for first-time, full-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students in the Fall 2020 at Westchester Community College is **23.3%**.

The success rate for students recognizes that many students come to the community college with the intent of transferring before degree completion or may take longer to graduate. With these factors in mind, the success rate for the fall 2020 cohort is **54.2%**.
