Graduation/Completion Rate Report

In accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Westchester Community College provides the following information on the graduation/completion rates for five cohorts of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who enrolled during the fall semester. While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

- Students who already attended another postsecondary institution or who began their studies on part-time basis are not reflected in the graduation or transfer-out rates
- Graduation rates are based on degree or certificate seekers completing within 150% of the normal time-to-completion
- Transfer-out rates are based on students from the cohort who transferred to another school within 150% of the normal time-to-completion without completing a degree or certificate
