Lehman College is a senior liberal arts college in The City University of New York, founded in 1968. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 9,863, with a gender distribution of 31.3 percent male students and 68.7 percent female students. Its setting is urban, and the campus size is 37 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. CUNY--Lehman College's ranking in the 2013 edition of Best Colleges is Regional Universities (North), 118. The student-faculty ratio at CUNY--Lehman College is 13:1, and the school has 34.7 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at CUNY--Lehman College include: Business Administration and Management, General; Adult Health Nurse/Nursing; Sociology; Social Work; and Psychology, General. CUNY--Lehman College is part of the NCAA III athletic conference.
