Dominican College is a private institution that was founded in 1952. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 1,643, with a gender distribution of 32.9 percent male students and 67.1 percent female students. Its setting is suburban, and the campus size is 70 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. Its tuition and fees are \$23,970 (2012-13). The student-faculty ratio at Dominican College is 15:1, and the school has 61.8 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at Dominican College include: Health Professions and Related Programs; Business, Management, Marketing, and Related Support Services; Social Sciences; Education; and English Language and Literature/Letters. At this school, 45.0 percent of the students live in college-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing and 55.0 percent of students live off campus. Dominican College is part of the NCAA II athletic conference.
