Marymount Manhattan College will guarantee admission for students that complete specific Associate Degree programs including Communication and Media Studies, Global Business, Business Administration, Liberal Arts and Sciences/Humanities, Liberal Arts and

Sciences/Social Sciences, Liberal Arts and Sciences/Mathematics and Science, Journalism, Marketing, and Digital Filmmaking at Westchester Community College. Students will be required to have a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA by the start of their final semester of their associate program (or final evaluation will be reviewed at the culmination of the associate degree in the hope that the student will reach a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater.) Students will receive 60 credits to transfer to Marymount Manhattan College for all coursework completed at Westchester Community College as long as they receive a final grade of "A" "B" or "C" (C- also accepted.) Students that complete their associate program with a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater would receive the \$2000 per year Articulation Grant. This award would be allotted to the student once per year for a maximum of three years provided they maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
