Founded in 1950, the main campus of Mercy College is located in Dobbs Ferry, New York. Programs are also offered at additional campuses in the Bronx, Manhattan, Yorktown Heights, and online. Mercy College is a private institution that was founded in 1950. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 7,968, with a gender distribution of 32.9 percent male students and 67.1 percent female students. Its setting is suburban, and the campus size is 55 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. Mercy College's ranking in the 2013 edition of Best Colleges is Regional Universities (North), Tier 2. The College is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and offers more than 90 in-demand undergraduate and graduate programs. The student-faculty ratio at Mercy College is 18:1, and the school has 55.6 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at Mercy College include: Social Sciences; Health Professions and Related Programs; Business, Management, Marketing, and Related Support Services; Psychology; and Homeland Security, Law Enforcement, Firefighting and Related Protective Services. At this school, 4.0 percent of the students live in college-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing and 96.0 percent of students live off campus. Mercy College is part of the NCAA II athletic conference.

### General stipulations at a glance:

- **WCC AA, AS, AAS degree graduates with a cumulative GPA of 2.00 will be granted junior status at Mercy College**
- **WCC AS or AAS degree graduates where a minimum of 48 liberal art credits are part of their degree will be deemed to have fulfilled all General Education requirements**
- **Transferrable credits for courses taken for a student's major must have a grade "C" or better, Courses with a grade "D" can transfer, but may be applied to General Education or open elective credit**
- **Upon transferring, WCC graduates will be awarded up to a maximum of 75 credits earned at WCC (or other two year college) as applicable to programs at Mercy College. An additional 15 credits may be transferred from a 4 year institution.**
