Morgan State University is a public institution that was founded in 1867. Morgan State University is Maryland's public urban university. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 6,711, with a gender distribution of 43.4 percent male students and 56.6 percent female students. Its setting is urban, and the campus size is 143 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. Its in-state tuition and fees are \$7,082 (2012-13); out-of-state tuition and fees are \$16,426 (2012-13). The student-faculty ratio at Morgan State University is 14:1, and the school has 40.4 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at Morgan State University include: Business, Management, Marketing, and Related Support Services; Engineering; Communication, Journalism, and Related Programs; Health Professions and Related Programs; and Social Sciences. At this school, 30.0 percent of the students live in college-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing and 70.0 percent of students live off campus. Morgan State University is part of the NCAA I athletic conference.
