New York Institute of Technology (also known as NYIT) is a private, non-sectarian, co-educational research university in New York City. NYIT has five schools and two colleges, all with a strong emphasis on technology and applied scientific research. The university has two New York campuses, one in Old Westbury Long Island and one near Columbus Circle in Manhattan, as well as several global campuses and programs (e.g. Bahrain, Canada, China, Jordan, United Arab Emirates). NYIT offers a total of 90 undergraduate degree, graduate degree programs, and medical degree programs to 14,000 students in academic areas such as architecture and design; arts and sciences; education; engineering and computing sciences; health professions; management; and osteopathic medicine.

General stipulations at a glance:

- **Admission:** Westchester Community College graduates with an Associate’s degree who meet the minimum criteria for degree program admission will be granted automatic admission into our undergraduate NYIT academic programs except for those programs that do not accept transfer students, such as: Life Science/Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine and the Life Science/Masters in Physician Assistant.
- **Transfer of Credits:** Westchester Community College graduates with an Associate’s degree who matriculate at NYIT as full-time or part-time students will be eligible to receive up to 70 transfer credits at NYIT as per the individual program articulation agreements that will be continuously created and updated. Wherever possible, course substitutions will be made for NYIT non-major requirements to ensure maximum transferability of credit for Westchester Community College graduates.
- **Financial Aid:** Westchester Community College graduates with an Associate’s degree will receive a Financial Aid Estimate within three (3) business days of their admission to NYIT to allow for stronger understanding of the cost of attending NYIT. NYIT offers more than \$26 million in

scholarships and need-based grants to enable students, including Westchester Community College transfer students, to attend NYIT.

- **Scholarships:** Westchester Community College graduates with an Associate’s degree who matriculate at NYIT only as full-time students (taking at least 12 credits per semester) will automatically receive a transfer scholarship if they meet the following criteria:

The amounts above are annual awards, renewable for two (2) years, or four (4) semesters, provided that the students maintain the requisite cumulative grade point averages as outlined in the scholarship award letter and maintain contiguous full-time matriculation.
