Pace University is a private institution that was founded in 1906. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 8,025, with a gender distribution of 41.3 percent male students and 58.7 percent female students. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. The school is comprised of two main campuses; a suburban campus in Pleasantville, NY and an urban campus located in lower Manhattan in the Financial District. Undergraduates have on-campus housing options at both locations, though many students choose to commute. The student-faculty ratio at Pace University is 11:1, and the school has 46.3 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at Pace University include: Business, Management, Marketing, and Related Support Services; Communication, Journalism, and Related Programs; Health Professions and Related Programs; Psychology; and Visual and Performing Arts. At this school, 40.0 percent of the students live in college-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing and 60.0 percent of students live off campus. Pace University is part of the NCAA II athletic conference.
