University at Albany--SUNY is a public institution that was founded in 1844. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 12,779, with a gender distribution of 51.4 percent male students and 48.6 percent female students. Its setting is suburban, and the campus size is 586 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. University at Albany--SUNY's ranking in the 2013 edition of Best Colleges is National Universities, 131. The student-faculty ratio at University at Albany--SUNY is 19:1, and the school has 22.7 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at University at Albany--SUNY include: Social Sciences; English Language and Literature/Letters; Business, Management, Marketing, and Related Support Services; Psychology; and Biological and Biomedical Sciences. At this school, 57.0 percent of the students live in college-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing and 43.0 percent of students live off campus. University at Albany--SUNY is part of the NCAA I athletic conference.
