Purchase College--SUNY is a public institution that was founded in 1967. It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 4,148, with a gender distribution of 43.9 percent male students and 56.1 percent female students. Its setting is suburban, and the campus size is 550 acres. It utilizes a semester-based academic calendar. Purchase College--SUNY's ranking in the 2013 edition of Best Colleges is National Liberal Arts Colleges, 175. The student-faculty ratio at Purchase College--SUNY is 16:1, and the school has 72.4 percent of its classes with fewer than 20 students. The most popular majors at Purchase College--SUNY include: Visual and Performing Arts; Liberal Arts and Sciences, General Studies and Humanities; Social Sciences; Communication, Journalism, and Related Programs; and English Language and Literature/Letters. At this school, 67.0 percent of the students live in college-owned, -operated, or -affiliated housing and 33.0 percent of students live off campus. Purchase College--SUNY is part of the NCAA III athletic conference.

General Stipulations at a glance:

- **Associate's Degree graduates of WCC who satisfy the minimum GPA of 2.5 and any audition or portfolio admission requirements in program list will be admitted into the parallel program at Purchase College**
- **Admitted students who meet the above requirements will be deemed to have satisfied Purchase College's core and proficiency requirements**
- **WCC graduates admitted under this agreement should have already successfully completed a minimum of 7 of the 10 SUNY general education requirements or degree completion may require additional time**
- **Associate's Degree graduates admitted under this agreement into Purchase College liberal arts programs will be granted full junior standing and will not be required to repeat any course at Purchase College that has been successfully completed at WCC.**
- **Associate's Degree graduates admitted under this agreement into Purchase College's conservatory or liberal arts programs with audition or portfolio admission requirements may, depending on the student's level of work, be required to complete more than 4 semesters of full time work in order to earn their Bachelor's Degree**
- **A maximum of 75 credits can be transferred, subject to Purchase College's specific program and/or institutional requirements.**
