



Kalmia latifolia

Common name: Mountain Laurel

Hardiness: Zones 4 - 9

Light: Sun to Light Shade

Soil: Average to Moist; prefers acidic soil with good drainage

Size: 4' – 10' tall x 4'– 10' wide (variable)

Foliage: Evergreen, dark green leaves

Flowers: White to pink (variable)

Bloom Time: Late spring to early summer

Wildlife Value: Good winter cover for wildlife
