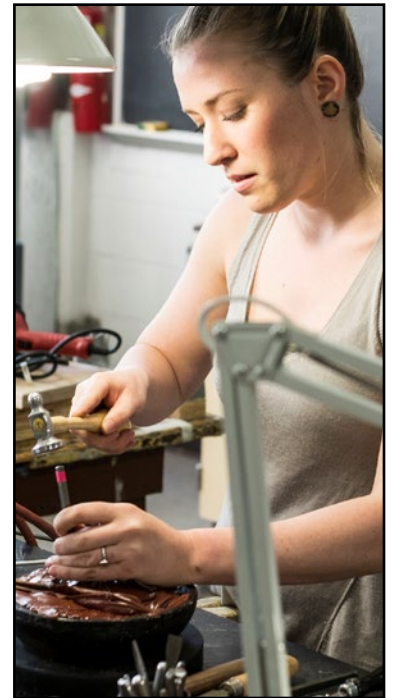
## Jewelry Fabrication Certificate

---

Centered primarily in New York City, the jewelry industry is a rapidly growing and lucrative business valued at 71.3 billion dollars. Over 40 gem and jewelry companies recruit professionals in this business every year – a recent search at the employment website Indeed.com yielded 304 job postings for jewelers in the New York City area. A bench jeweler's salary can range from \$50-\$65,000 per year or \$16-\$27 per hour and requires no degree, just the knowledge and skill of jewelry techniques. In addition, there is great potential for individual jewelers and crafts people to start their own business online. This certificate would provide the technical skills needed and the portfolio of work required enabling students to pursue multiple avenues in the jewelry industry. Such opportunities include entering the jewelry/accessory business as a bench jeweler or sales associate, transfer to a 4-year bachelors program, or start their own business.

The non-credit Jewelry Fabrication Certificate can be completed in three semesters.
