A. President's Report

Dr. Belinda S. Miles reported:

- Welcome to the first board meeting of <u>2018</u> and the first board meeting of our <u>spring term</u>. With today's weather, we will have to remember springtime in our hearts.
- As I have been visiting different groups at the college, one word has come to mind. "WOW"! There are wow stories in every direction that we turn. Students say "WOW" about every interaction with a faculty member, staff member, or administrator. Another wow factor are our faculty accomplishments we will speak more them in a resolution for tenure and reappointment this afternoon. A huge WOW factor is our men's basketball.
